

Thank you for your interest in the responsible operations of Newmont Mining Corporation's Cripple Creek & Victor Gold Mining Company.

As we have explained, in order to eliminate the safety hazards caused by a public crossing of an active mining haul road, the American Eagles Overlook Site near Victor, Colorado, has been closed. While this decision was clearly made for safety reasons, which is paramount to everyone's best interest, Newmont CC&V understands the importance of this site and will continue to work with our local community to provide new benefits and opportunities to the region.

In addition to Newmont CC&V's on-going historic mining structure preservation efforts, continuing support for community events, and our popular modern mining tour program, CC&V is working with our local community and governments to plan and permit new overlook areas which will provide tourism benefits to the region.

The first of these overlooks, which is currently in the permitting process, will be located just outside the active mining boundary on the north side of CC&V's property (off of Teller County Road 82) and will feature a spectacular overlook of our large scale, modern mining operations.

Following the necessary planning, permitting, and investment process, the community can anticipate the opening of a site, located near Victor, Colorado, that will provide a

safe location for the public to view a historic mine site as well as the area's mountain vistas.

Newmont CC&V understands the importance of investing in the cooperative relationships and projects that make this region, and its mining heritage, an attractive and economically viable community. We look forward to continuing our work together and will communicate on these complex issues as they evolve.
