

Expressions of Interest Requested

QJ341 Sandvik Crusher Operations & Maintenance Services
Kinross Tasiast Mauritanie Ltd. S.A. (TML S.A.)

Tasiast Gold Mine commenced operations in 2007 and in 2010 TMLSA, a wholly owned Kinross Gold Corporation subsidiary, acquired the mining lease. The open pit operation is located in the Saharan desert of western Mauritania approximately 300km north of the capital, Nouakchott and 162km east-southeast of the port city of Nouadhibou in Mauritania, West Africa.

TMLSA is seeking interest from contractors qualified in providing high quality Services and Resources during an specific period of time for to provide comprehensive operation and maintenance services for two mobile sandvik QJ341 crushing unit located at the Company Tasiast mine site. The Services shall be performed in accordance with the applicable standards and specifications for operating the crushing unit.

Technical Requirements

1. Fully autonomous operation and maintenance service including material handling; this means that the selected contractor must be capable of providing load and haul services using adequate loaders and trucks within an active mining area.
2. This will consist of handling approximately 4 to 6 ktpd of moved and crushed material, consisting of unprocessed ROM low-grade gold ore extracted from the mine pit.
3. The contractor's responsibilities will include loading the material from dedicated stockpiles to the Sandvik crushers (no work inside the pit is required), conducting the crushing operation, performing maintenance tasks, and transporting crushed materials to dedicated crusher stockpiles. The material specifications are:
 - Density: 1.9 tonne/m³
 - Size distribution: P80: 320mm
4. Key responsibilities further include crushers installation, commissioning, day-to-day management, and adherence to health, safety, and environmental compliance standards.
5. Ensure prestart checks are completed each shift.
6. Perform daily checks/ complete log sheets in accordance with Standard Operating Procedures for the crushing equipment, which shall be recorded and submitted to Company Technical Representative.
7. Perform daily operations of circuit as per agreed operating procedures.
8. Adjust and record daily the crushers closed side setting to proper measurement
9. Program sizes of screens to keep production within specifications
10. Ensure guarding and barricading is maintained according to Company's standards
11. Perform housekeeping ensuring that all workshops are kept clean and in good

Commercial Requirements

1. Interested contractors should **be registered having the RC and N.I.F numbers;**
2. Indicate experience in the requested domain(s) **at least Five years in** Crusher Operations & Maintenance Services and/or mobile equipment operation services. An added advantage will be with the companies working with Large international or national mining companies;
3. Tax clearance certificate or exemption and **proof of compliance to social security requirements.** The Company will establish if this is a requirement in the country;
4. **References**, at least list three most important clients, including the contact name, title, Email address, the length of contract and contract value;
5. **CVs of the relevant key personnel**, such as the Managing Director or the Site Manager who will be supervising the works, with experience of at least three years in their areas of specialization especially for the provision of maintenance services.
