The audience will be encouraged to dialogue with the panel participants about ongoing applicability in establishing evidence-based practices to promote sustainable employment outcomes for program participants.

"The incorporation of advanced analytics into the operations of public programs can help governments deliver better outcomes for the citizens they serve," said Dr. Woteki. "For participants of SNAP and TANF programs, this means taking a more targeted approach to service delivery, providing support activities that are tailored to each individual's estimated likelihood of success instead of a one-size-fits-all approach."

The AASD/NASTA Annual Education Conference brings together colleagues from across the nation in both government and private sectors to exchange ideas and discuss policies surrounding the administration of SNAP and TANF programs.
