Organizations that are tax-exempt as defined by the U.S. Internal Revenue Code, government agencies, and public and private educational institutions are eligible for consideration.

To apply for funding:

- Complete the application for funding
- Answer each question **fully**
- Attach a copy of your most recent financial statements and/or a budget for your event or project
- All applications **must be deemed complete and received at least three weeks prior to** any quarterly meeting date to be reviewed at that meeting.
- **All applications received incomplete or, after the "three week prior to" deadline will be reviewed once all requirements are met, at the following quarterly meeting.**

Applications reviewed on a quarterly basis. Meeting dates for 2021:

- January 28
- April 28
- July 28
- October 27

The following organizations are generally ineligible for funding through the Newmont CC&V Community Investment Program:

- Individual pursuits or stand-alone research
- Feasibility studies
- Debt-reduction campaigns
- Political parties or candidates (may not provide personal benefit for a government official)
- Religious organizations (except where they represent non-denominational community and social support services)
- Professional solicitors or third-party fund raising
- Programs outside of the communities near our operation
