Ritchie Bros. will sell equipment and trucks for 260+ companies at the Fort Worth auction, including Neuhaus & Co., Ltd., an agricultural equipment dealer with four locations in the Rio Grande Valley. In operation for 50+ years, Neuhaus & Co. will sell 12 late-model John Deere 6150R MFWD tractors in the auction.

"When you buy from Ritchie Bros. you pay market value, with no reserves. You also have access to a number of convenient services, including financing," said Lance Neuhaus, President of Neuhaus & Co., Ltd. "All the tractors we're selling are rental units, only used for pulling sugarcane wagons. Day Two of the Fort Worth auction will be 'transportation day'. More than 150 Kenworth transport trucks, 40+ Peterbilts, as well as Internationals, Freightliners and other trucks will be sold.
