THE COURT:

Respondent is ORDERED to show cause why the relief sought in the petition should not be granted. Absent objection on or before March 21, 2019, the preliminary opposition filed by real party in interest will be deemed its return to the order to show cause. In the event of an objection, real party in interest may file a return to the order to show cause on or before April 15, 2019. Petitioner may file a reply to the return on or before May 6, 2019.

Absent a written request from a party on or before May 13, 2019, oral argument will be deemed waived. If a party requests oral argument, the request should be in letter form with proof of service on the other parties. The letter should also identify the amount of time requested, not to exceed 15 minutes.
