



BEACON HONORS MILITARY VETERANS, KICKS OFF ANNUAL NATIONWIDE *BEACON OF HOPE* CONTEST

The public is encouraged to nominate a deserving veteran now through September 24

Ten finalists will be announced in early October, and the public will have an opportunity to vote for their favorite finalists. Beacon will announce the winners and runners-up on Veterans Day.

Last year, people from across the country came together to cast thousands of votes for the ten finalist whose roofs were in dire need of repair or replacement.
